Did you know:

Lead

- Violence against women costs Australia \$21.7 billion a year (PWC 2015)
- In 2018, workplace sexual harassment cost \$3.5 billion (Australian Human Rights Commission 2020)
- Employers bore 70% of the financial costs of this harassment (Australian Human Rights Commission 2020)
- A study by the Grattan Institute showed that a 6% increase in female workforce participation would add \$25 billion to national GDP (Australian Human Rights Commission 2020)

Benefits of taking action in your workplace:

- Gender-diverse companies are 15% more likely to notice higher financial returns (McKinsey 2020)
- Diverse companies are 70% more likely to capture new markets (HBR 2022)
- Diverse teams are 87% better at making decisions (People Management 2017)
- Inclusive organsiations are 47% more likely to retain staff (McKinsey 2022)
- Millennials are 83% more likely to be engaged at work at inclusive companies (Deloitte 2022)


