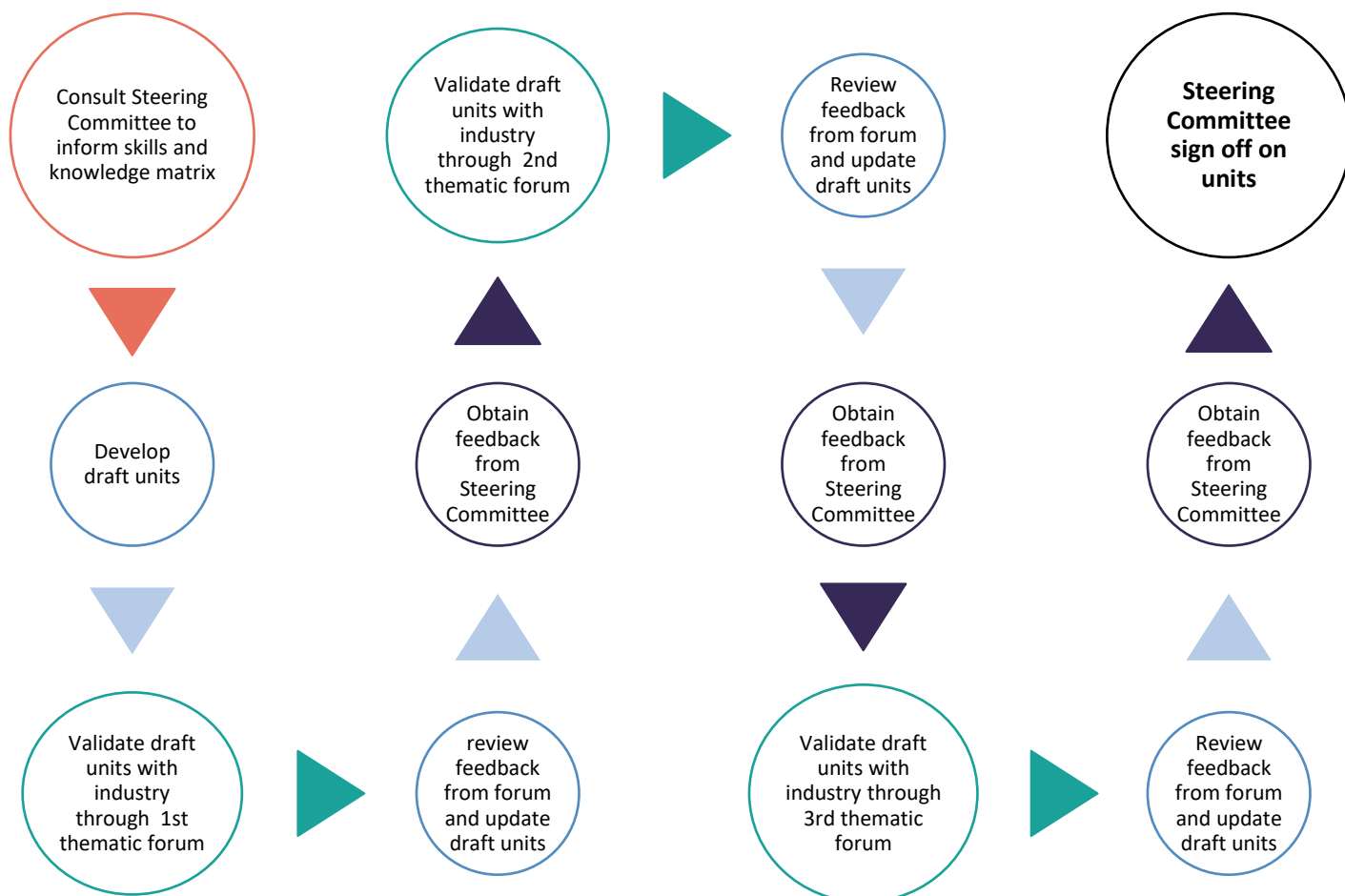

The skills and knowledge outcomes have been developed and validated using a full and transparent industry consultation process that has utilised a cyclical approach to consultation, development and review.



Three thematic forums were held:

1. Intersectional Forum to inform the context within which an intersectional approach was embedded within the units of competency. Attended by a range of agencies supporting intersectional approaches to client services and members of the Steering Committee.
2. Industry Forum to inform the work context and workplace application of the units of competency. Attended by a range of industries and sectors and members of the Steering Committee.
3. Education Forum to inform the pedagogical approach required to support effective training and assessment of the units of competency and to validate that the skills and knowledge met the performance criteria expectations and could be assessed appropriately through the assessment approach defined within the Evidence Guide of the units of competency. Attended by a range of educators from secondary, vocational and higher education streams and members of the Steering Committee.
